Barr's Tyres is currently owned and operated by Cr Barr.

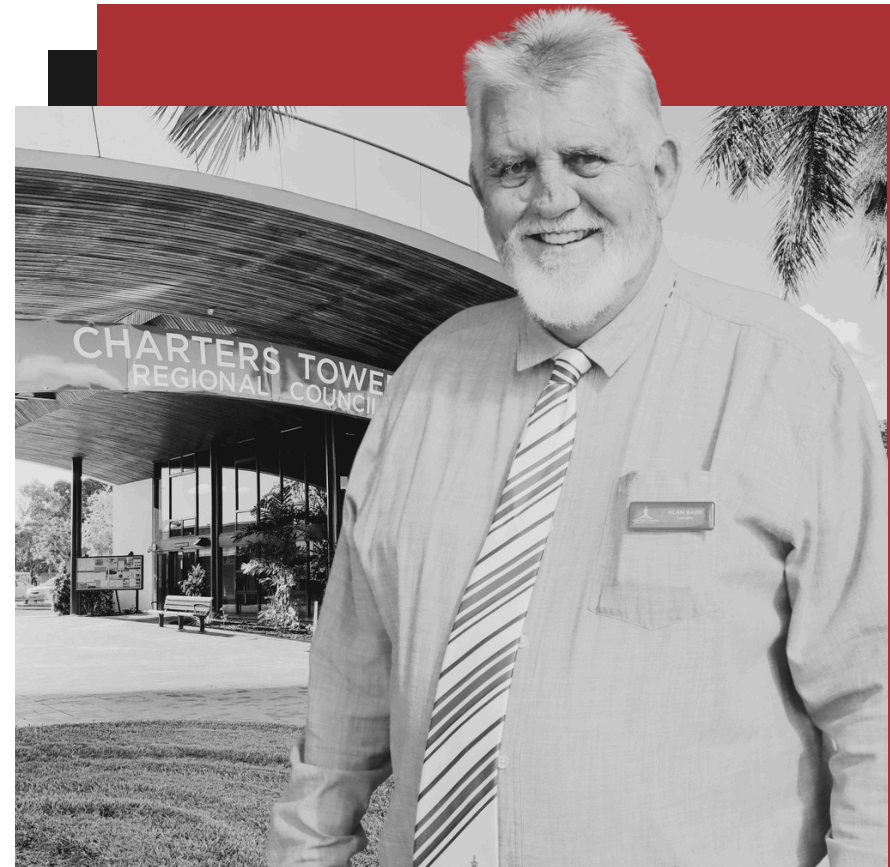
Key Achievements:
